The 66 Collier Street high-rise residential condominium, which is more than 30 years old, needed an update to compete with newer condos under construction in Toronto’s upscale Yonge and Bloor neighborhood.

The formerly drab, outdated corridors were redesigned with Shaw Hospitality Group carpet, artwork, lighting and upholstered benches to create a straightforward, simple design that appeals to all condo homeowners.

The custom variation of the A Thousand Leaves print carpet bridges traditional and modern styling in the shared public space corridors of the 14-story condo. The 36-inch square medallions delineate the four owners’ suite doors per floor while the larger accent rug at the elevators establishes a sense of arrival.
